## EVALUATION SYSTEM

- In an educational Year, three periodic assessment (PA1, PA2, PA3) and two sessional i.e. half-yearly and yearly assessment are conducted. Students have to qualify each exam.
- Board students/examinees of std 10th & 12th have to pass each exam i.e. monthly test, half yearly and pre-board exams otherwise they can be detained/deprived from Board Exam.
- It is important/compulsory to qualify 'Cultural knowledge test (not below 50%) conducted by the school.
- It is intimated that only formal exams will not be considered to qualify or disqualify any student. Each work either written or practical or oral as well as home work is well evaluated/assessed.

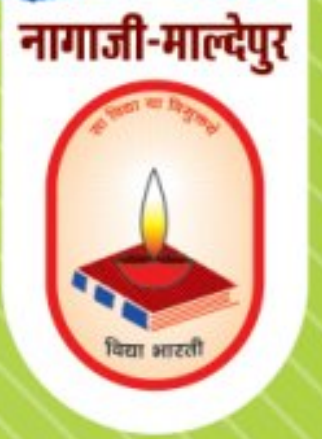

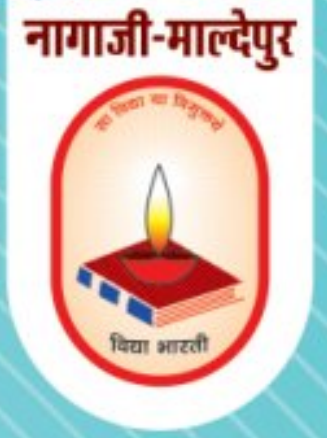

## HEALTH CHECK-UP

- Each student will under go a health checkup twice a year.
- A cost-effective surcharge will be payable for vaccinations against Cholera, Typhoid, Smallpox and Covid-19.
- Other Health related information will be sent to parents in due course.



## DISCIPLINARY RULES



- If a student remains absent for three consecutive days without prior approval, His/Her name may be struck off from the school register.
- For taking irregular leave, a fine will be payable as per rules.
- To obey all school rules and regulation, such as those relating to dress code, Personal conduct, other behavioural duties and not to damage school property and legacy.
- Discipline should be an essential part of a student's life. Any misbehaviour will result in expulsion from the School.
- Every student must have 90% attendance before each monthly exam, less than 90% attendance may result in the Student being.
- In case of absence of a student, the leave application should be approved by the Principal one day in advance and should reach the class teacher, otherwise the student will be absent.
- Board: examines (class 10th and 12th) must pass all weekly, monthly, Half-yearly and predictive examination conducted by the school and appear for all the teaching days. Attendance is mandatory in all programmes organised in the school.
- Disciplinary action can be taken against the student if he/she takes home tuition without prior permission from any teacher of the school.
- Attendance is mandatory for all students on Independence Day, Republic Day, Basant Panchami, Guru Purnima, Varsha Pratipada etc. Absentees will incur financial penalty as determined by the school.
- Bringing any unwanted magazine, book, electronic items (mobile and transistor) which do not contribute to the teaching-learning process is prohibited and punishable in the school.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in school premises and elsewhere. Students are required to come to school daily in the prescribed uniform. Incomplete uniforms may be returned back from the school, while parents will be solely responsible for this.
- Students have fixed arrival and departure for school. No departures are permitted, in exceptional circumstances students will be sent with their parents.



- Students are required to arrive at school by allotted-time. Students will not be permitted to enter the school if they are late or after the main gate closes.
- Parents who arrive at the school should contact the Principal or the office to resolve any Concerns: Direct meeting with the teacher or their ward is not permitted.
- Students must travel to school using a bicycle, school bus or private vehicles. Motorcycles, scooters or electric vehicles are prohibited.
- Action will be taken on undesirable activities by the student as per the recommendation of the Discipline Committee
- Students will be given a certificate of appreciation for their good work and a student who receives three certificates of appreciation in a session will be rewarded.
- If the fee is not deposited on time, the name of the student will be struck off from the attendance register. Entry in the attendance register will be given only after completing the process with the permission of the Principal.
- All school related information is exchanged electronically, as well as in written form in the student diary.
- The Principal reserves the right to expel any student from the school for reasons such as indiscipline, In case of expulsion, all fees deposited will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- In the event of damage to school property or other misconduct a financial penalty will be imposed as determined by the Discipline Committee. The school administration will not be responsible for any damage or incident outside the school premises.
- To maintain discipline in the school campus, floor in-charges are appointed on all floors and a discipline head brother/sister is also selected for each class in each session. (The teacher is the only in-charge) and a discipline incharge for the entire school is selected by the Principal.
- For any problem, contact the Principal or the office.
- Educational tours, talent development classes and Yoga Camps are essential components of our education System. Therefore, upon receiving information a student must participate and attend the scheduled events.
- The school fees have to be deposited on time.
- The Parents will be solely responsible for picking up and bringing their children back from school.

## Rules for School Transport Service

1. The School transport will be available for students from Pre-Primary to Class-12 on the basis of parent's demand and availability of seats.
2. The routes of the school vehicles are fixed.
3. Transport facility is available only to those students who come to school from a distance more than 02 Kms.
4. School transport facilities will be provided in order of priority.
5. Be careful while entering and exiting the vehicle.
6. Reach at bus stop before the Scheduled time.
7. Do not make noise, as this may distract the driver.
8. Board or get off the vehicle only when it completely stops.
9. Parents should visit to school regarding any vehicle-related issues. Avoid speaking with the driver or bus conductor.
10. No route changes will be entertained in the middle of the session for the students registered in vehicles.
11. If a student comes to school by school vehicle, and due to some reasons, departs from the School early with his/her parents before complete school dismissal, then it will be mandatory to notify the vehicle in-charge and driver.
12. If a student comes to school by vehicle and at school dismissal, he/she neither uses the vehicle or notify the vehicle incharge, then his /her registration will be cancelled.
13. School vehicles are available only on the main routes (with limited seats) of Ballia city.





## Rules for suspension

1. In case, fee is not paid on time.
2. a) Students being in disciplined.  
b) Immoral acts and inhumane behaviour.
- c) Engaged directly in ruckus or prohibited activities within or outside school premises, or participating in any sorts of plotting against school's dignity and prestige.
3. No amount will be refunded, in case of suspension of student from the School.
4. No admission will be accepted if once suspended.

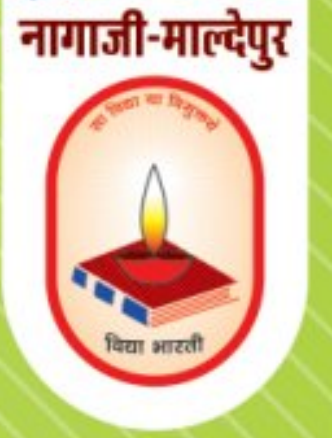

## Fees Information

1. The session will begin On Thursday, 02 April 2026. (April 2026 to March 2027)
2. Fees are payable in fixed four installments (April, July, September and November). However, entire year's fees can be paid in one go.
3. Fees must be payable by due date the the designated time for fee payment is 7:30 am to 11:00 am in morning Schedule and 9:30 am to 01:30 pm in full-time schedule.
  - (a) Fees must be paid on 5-6, 10-11, 15-16, 20-21, 25-26 and 28 of each month.
  - (b) Pay fees for each month on the basis of fees description.
    - If fee is not paid on 28/29 of said month, then student's name will be struck off from the school register.
    - Re-admission shall be granted after payment of late fine ₹ 100/- month alongwith the amount.
4. In case of a student's withdrawal from academic session, the fees for the entire period upto the month of September shall be payable.
  - Should the withdrawal take place after September, the full fee upto the month of March shall be mandatorily payable.





5. The prescribed fees do not include board registration fee and board examination fee. If your ward is to appear in board examination, his fee shall be payable within given time.
6. The fees deposited in the school shall be non-refundable.
7. The transport fee is not included in the school fee and shall be payable separately as per the prescribed regulations.
8. A monthly transport fee of ₹ 1300/- month alongwith the school fees shall be payable for the entire year, students availing transport facility (bus).
9. Transport fee shall be payable along with the tuition fee. Students availing school transport must pay vehicle fee upto September-If a student discontinues the bus service in mid-session. Withdrawal after October will require payment of the vehicle fee upto March.
10. To avail transport facility, get yourselves registered and receive Vehicle card. No entry is allowed without it.
11. The examination fee prescribed by the board shall be payable in the month of August separately of students studying in class 10th & 12th, about which they will be informed on the basis of the instructions received from the board.
12. Students studying in classes 9th and 11th shall pay registration fee as per the notification of the board.

### Hostel Fee

Annual hostel fee, for classes 6th to 8th is ₹55000/-. Parents are urged to pay it alongwith school fees. For the convenience of parents, hostel fee can be paid in two easy installments. First installment (₹27500/-) in April and second installment (₹27500/-) in September.





## Admission Process 2026-27

1. Application form for entrance test may be obtained from the office paying ₹ 400 by 15th January 2026.
2. An entrance test will be held for new students' admission.
3. The last date for submission of application form for classes Nursery to 5th is 21 February 2026.
4. The entrance test of Classes Nursery to 5th will be held on 22 February, from 08:30 am to 10:30 am.
5. The last date for submission of application form for classes 6th to 9th is 14th March 2026.
6. The entrance test of classes 6th to 9th will take place on 15th March 2026, from 08:30 am to 10:30 am.
7. The entrance test will cover questions from Hindi, Mathematics, English, Science and other Subjects prescribed by CBSE.
8. Application form for class XI (Securing 75% marks in 10th) will be available on counter from the next day after the announcement of class-X examination result.
9. The entrance test for admission in class XI is scheduled on 27 June 2026, starting at 08:00 am. The questions will be based on classes IX and X syllabi and will cover the subjects of Mathematics, Science, English and Hindi.
10. Students will bring necessary stationery with themselves except question booklet and answer sheet.
11. List of Selected students of classes Nursery to 5th and 6th to 9th will be available on notice board and website.
12. The Selected students may take admission from 17 March 2026 to 31 March 2026. Beyond this period, it shall not be considered.
13. It is inevitable to submit TC (Transfer Certificate) at the time of admission of selected students.



14. Admission of old students of all classes will begin from 1st April 2026, which lasts upto 5th April 2026.
15. New session (2026-27) will commence from 2nd April 2026.
16. Admission will be granted on the basis of the merit of the entrance test. Exceeding prescribed period, admission shall not be possible.
17. Admission will be granted only by paying total fees.
18. The promoted students will have to mandatorily take admission by 15th April 2026 by paying prescribed fees. And if they do not secure their admission, then school management/administration will not be bound for granting admission.
19. Admission of student shall be considered cancelled, if absent for continuously one week from the date of session commencement.

## HOSTEL ALLOTMENT

- Hostel allotment is based on the merit list of written exams and interview of the students.
- Medical certificate issued by medical officer is mandatory for hostel allotment.
- There are 150 seats in the hostel for the students.
- Hostel fees of the students will be deposited to the office only.
- Total Hostel fees may be deposited for the whole session in one installment.
- A receipt for any deposited amount is mandatory if any complaint/ suggestion.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE STUDENTS OF HOSTEL

- Students should follow the rules and regulations of the hostel and maintain discipline.
- Students should follow the daily routine of the hostel.
- Students are not allowed to leave school premises without any permission of the hostel superintendent.
- Student should be careful towards the cleanliness of their bed, classroom, premises etc.
- Students belongings should be at their particular place.
- Writing on the doors, windows and walls is not allowed.
- Students should understand their own duty and responsibility towards the safety of school and its premises.
- Students should study the subjects deeply and prepare the proper notes of each subject to achieve at least 50% marks.
- Students should wake up as soon as the morning alarm sounds and go to bed after the lights turn off at night.



## GENERAL FACILITIES

- Students will be provided the facilities of hair cutting, shoes mending, washing and stitching clothes.
- Accommodation and generator facilities are provided within the hostel premises.
- Visiting hours for parents are fixed for the last Sunday of each month from 8:00 am to 5:00pm.
- Accommodation for guardians/parents in the hostel will be in special circumstances.

## GENERAL RULES OF THE HOSTEL

- Parents must contact the office or hostel superintendent before meeting a student.
- No leave will be granted for outside coaching classes.
- The School / Hostel administration will not be responsible for any accidental injuries.
- Contact of the parents with their children should be minimal.
- Parents are expected to have an encouraging conversation with their newly admitted ward over the phone once every fifteen days.
- Local guardians/parents can visit on the last Sunday of the month but can not take the ward outside.
- First-aid facilities are available at the hostel. There are also appropriate arrangements to take the child to the hospital if needed.
- Don't be panic if you come to know the child is sick. He is adequately cared for by the hostel. The cost of first-aid is borne by the school.
- On arrival at the hostel be sure to contact concerned co- superintendent/superintendent regarding the boy's progress.
- Before making any decision, be sure to get information about the situation from the hostel superintendent.
- Valuable items like mobile phones cameras or any expensive jewellery are prohibited.



- The hostel has sports facilities, so parents are advised not to give any sport equipments.
- Similarly, don't give newspapers, magazines, unnecessary items and cash.
- If you want to give money, deposit it in his saving account.
- Instead of unnecessary expenses on birthdays, encourage the good practice of donating inspiring books useful for children to the hostel.
- Items given to the boys from home should be indigenous. Don't give them expensive and ostentatious items.
- It will be the responsibility of parents to take and drop off their ward at the appointed time when the holiday is declared by the hostel administration.
- Permission to go with someone else will be given upon the presentation of an authorized letter by the parents.
- In case of late return, a penalty fee of Rs.100 will be payable per day.
- The child will not be sent anywhere on any kind of request made by the parents over the phone.
- Your suggestions are always expected from time to time for the all round development of child and the progress of the hostel.
- The leaflets sent by the hostel also contain important information for parents. Parents are requested to take all the leaflets seriously and cooperate in due course.
- All the disputes will be heard under the jurisdiction of Ballia Court.
